

CNYR SCCA May 2026 Membership Meeting Minutes

The May 2026 meeting of the Central New York Region of the SCCA was held on Wednesday, May 13, 2026.

The meeting was held in the Community Room at the Cantina Taco Bell in Manlius, NY.

RE Mangicaro called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm. There were 5 attendees.

RE Report:

RE Mangicaro reported the following:

- Attended the Green Grand Prix at WGI on 4/10. Smaller crowd this year for autocross, so they got many runs on the 25 second course.
- Attended the Novice school and autocross on 4/25 & 4/26. Both days went well.
- Dropped off the Solo trailer to Rome Labs for the Tire Rack Street Survival 4/27 and returned it to EVOG 5/11. Dennis said the event went well, although they only had 7 students.
- Purchased a Solis hotspot with 1GB/month of lifetime data. Primary use is for autocross live timing. It tested good.
- Purchased 100 more tokens identical to what we have been using for fun runs.

Assistant RE Report:

ARE Schultz was not present. The Secretary passed on the following report from Bob:

1) Live Timing App!! Successfully worked with the developers to add CNYR to existing autocross apps for iOS and Android, linked below. Recommend the core group test it out in the morning on the Sat 5/16 event before we announce it to the "public", maybe at lunch if it's updating well? Don't need to be timing + troubleshooting + racing all at once. Later, we can make a sheet with QR codes and post to the trailer and/or add to Motorsportreg?
